#### **3. General Information about OCCAR**

OCCAR is an international organisation whose core business is the through-life management of cooperative defence equipment Programmes. The organisation was established by means of the OCCAR Convention, which is equivalent to an international treaty. The headquarters are located in Bonn, Germany.

OCCAR's Divisions that manage the specific programmes are located in several European countries.

#### **4. Subject and Scope of the Potential Contract**

OCCAR-EA has the intention to award up to 3 Framework Contracts for the procurement of COTS spares, consumables and services to support ground (SAMP/T) and naval (PAAMS, LRR, SAAM-FR, SAAM-IT & FREMM) defence systems already delivered to locations in France, Italy and the UK.

## **5. Anticipated Contract Duration and Value**

The Framework Contracts duration will be three years with a two-year option to extend to take the duration to a maximum of five years. The Framework Contracts are due to start in summer 2023.

The Framework Contract will be issued without a minimum or maximum value, but will be tailored to the Nations' requests.

No commitment to place any orders is given to the Contractors. Each Nations' request will be subject to a separate bidding process between the Framework Contract suppliers that will determinate the order values.

The total annual order values is estimated at around 4,000,000.00 € (indicative value), based on previous contracts.

## **7. Pre-Qualification Questionnaire (PQQ)**

Companies interested in this tender are invited to fill the PQQ accompanying the present Contract Notice published on OCCAR web site.

## **8. Registration of Interest**

Companies are invited to formalise their interest to participate in the future tendering activities via the e-mail referenced in section 2 above.

The due date for the registration of interest is **12 September 2022, 12:00 Central European Time (CET)**.

Any Company registering their interest must provide the following:

- Basic Information about the Company (name, legal form, headquarters location);
- Commercial Point of Contact (name, telephone number and e-mail address);
- Completed PQQ.

Only Supplier(s) who meet the criteria indicated in PQQ shall be invited to Tender phase for Contractor selection.

## **9. Important Notes**

9.1 All correspondence related to this Contract Notice shall be in English. Any correspondence received in a different language will not be accepted.

9.2 This advertisement is no commitment of a future contract and OCCAR-EA reserves the right not to pursue the tendering procedure. No expenses incurred in any tendering activities will be borne by OCCAR.

9.3 This competition is open to any companies within the European Union, OCCAR Member State and a Programme Participating State.

9.4 Companies based in any state other than Belgium, France, Germany, Italy, Spain or

the UK are to note the following:

- The tendering procedure as well as any resulting contracts may require the exchange of classified information between OCCAR-EA and the Company in accordance with OMP 11 (<http://www.occar.int/occar-rules>). This would require the establishment of a Security Agreement between OCCAR and the State the company is based in.
- OCCAR-EA recommends that Companies not based in Belgium, France, Germany, Italy, Spain or the UK liaise with their National Security Authority in order to initiate the establishment of a Security Agreement with OCCAR.
- The award of a contract, if any, to a Company from State other than Belgium, France, Germany, Italy, Spain or the UK may require the establishment of an agreement between OCCAR and the government of that State in accordance with the OCCAR Convention.
- OCCAR-EA recommends that Companies based in a State other than Belgium, France, Germany, Italy, Spain or the UK liaise immediately with their Ministry of Defence in order to clarify the requirement of such an agreement with OCCAR, and to initiate the establishment, if required.
